Regenerative Dialogue with High Levels of Engagement

Open Space Technology is a group intervention, which allows a large number of people to come together and have deep meaningful conversations across borders and silos over several days. It is the only social technology that has no pre-determined agenda and is therefore ideal where the outcome is unknowable (e.g. VUCA) and where the situation requires rich interactivity and diverse cross-pollinating dialogue to enable emergence. Open Space works particularly well where an urgent matter, conflict or complexity is involved, including for stakeholder dialogues.
